# Topic

Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology: From HPV to CPCs

PART 1: HPV-Related Lesions Affecting the Oral Cavity and Oropharynx

Synopsis: This presentation will provide the clinician with an update on HPV-related lesions affecting the oral cavity and oropharynx. Current information on HPV-related oropharyngeal squamous cell carcinoma (OPSCC) including the etiology, epidemiology, prognosis and prevention will be discussed. Emphasis will be placed on clinically relevant information. At the conclusion of the lecture, the practitioner will have the knowledge to answer HPV-related questions asked in the clinical setting.

#### PART 2: Clinico-Pathologic Case (CPC) Presentations

Synopsis: Using a case-based approach, this interactive presentation will provide the participant with the opportunity to use critical thinking skills. An approach to formulating differential diagnoses for the reactive, neoplastic and developmental conditions presented will be reviewed. The discussion will include several newly described entities in the oral pathology literature, as well as some oral manifestations of systemic diseases. At the conclusion of this presentation, the clinician will have reviewed some common, and some not so common but very significant oral lesions.

## Bio

Dr. Audrey Boros attended McGill University (Montreal, Canada) where she received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Anatomy and Cell Biology. She continued her studies at Queen's University (Kingston, Canada), earning a Master of Science Degree in Pathology and Molecular Medicine. In 2010, she received her Doctor of Dental Surgery from the University of Southern California Ostrow School of Dentistry. Following graduation, Dr. Boros pursued her interest in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, completing a three-year residency training program at New York Hospital Medical Center, Queens. During this time, Dr. Boros

received extensive diagnostic and clinical training in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. She is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and a Fellow of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. She is a laboratory director at Oral Pathology Associates in West Los Angeles and also practices Clinical Oral Pathology (Oral Medicine) in Santa Monica. She is a Part Time Assistant Professor at Western University of Health Sciences School of Dental Medicine and holds adjunct faculty appointments at LAC+USC Medical Center and USC Ostrow School of Dentistry. Dr. Boros is an active member of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and is also President-Elect for the Southern California Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology.
